El Salvador not only promised to give a free computer to each of its students, BUT also delivered, giving away more than 1.3 million tablets and computers, connected to the web, recognizing the importance of information for the advancement of the country.

Today, El Salvador is one of the leaders of the entire Latin American continent in the management and administration of COVID-19. We can evidence their efficiency. Productivity. Planning. Results.

And, in terms of development, the country is busily strengthening its foundations with new infrastructure, a solid industrial base, quality job creation and investment in human capital.

From being unnotable in foreign markets, El Salvador made headlines by becoming the first country in the world to recognize Bitcoin, a crypto-currency, as legal tender. Your country, Maddam Ambassador, broke paradigms by announcing the creation of a city that will be inaugurated under the name "Bitcoin City", attracting thousands and thousands of international investors from all over the world.
